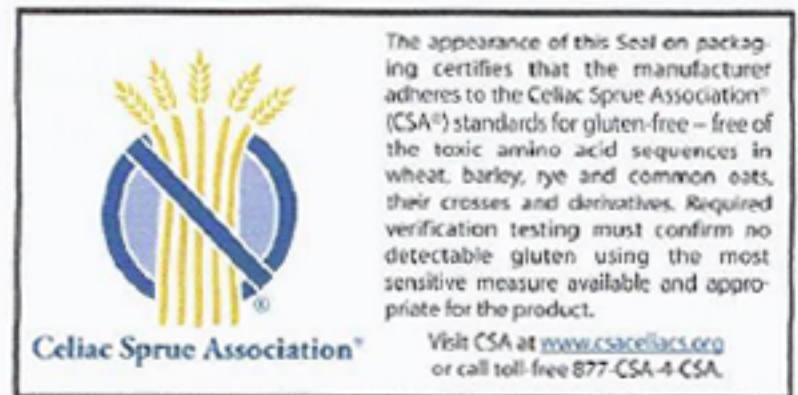

To Whom It May Concern:

Let it be known that Senza Glutine has met the certification requirements for the Celiac Sprue Association® Recognition Seal Program, the first program in the United States to recognize companies that meet the strictest criteria for gluten-free—i.e. free of the toxic amino acid sequences in wheat, barley, rye and common oats, as well as their crosses and derivatives. The CSA Recognition Seal Program is designed exclusively for products which are appropriate for a medically prescribed celiac diet.

This company has provided CSA with a copy of their specific procedures and policies necessary to produce gluten-free products. On-site inspections may be conducted. Verification testing through the University of Nebraska Food Allergy Resource and Research Program Laboratory (FARRP) confirms no detectable gluten using the most sensitive measure available and appropriate for the product. For most products a reading of Below Level of Quantitation at 5 parts per million is required for qualification for the program.

CSA commends Senza Glutine for all the efforts that have been made to provide safe and appropriate products for the nearly three million Americans who require a gluten-free diet.

The appearance of the CSA Recognition Seal indicates that procedures have been documented to assure gluten-free products, processing and packaging. Senza Glutine's customers can choose their products with confidence.
